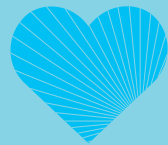

Multiple Pregnancies

When you are expecting two or more babies at the same time, it is called a 'multiple pregnancy'. About 1 in 80 pregnancies that report to a hospital are multiple pregnancies. Fertility treatments like In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF) increase the chances of multiple pregnancies.

Kinds of Multiple Pregnancy

TWINS. THEY ARE

- **Identical Twins**
One egg splits into two blastocysts. The babies look alike and are always the same sex.
- **Fraternal Twins**
Two eggs are fertilised by two different sperm in the same pregnancy. Babies can be of different sexes and don't look alike.

TRIPLETS, QUADRUPLETS, ETC.

- **More than two babies**
They can be a mix of identical and fraternal.
